

## 2.3 Links Between Person Centred Planning And Strategic Planning

The Partnership Board needs to make sure that **everybody** understands that new services, and new plans must come from the information from peoples' Person-Centred Plans.



In this way, they can be sure that they are helping people to live their lives as they want, and not in ways that other people think they ought to.

Staff in services must collect information about what people want and need. They must make sure that people who run services, and the Partnership Board are told about what is wanted.

Local Implementation Groups must make sure that they have ways of collecting the information and giving it to the people who need it, so that they can plan services properly

The picture on the next page should help people to understand that they need to listen to people, and then make sure that the information goes to the right organisations. This includes people who provide housing, people who run leisure centres, and clubs.



Lots of people would like to work, so we need to make sure that people who can help to make that happen, know how important it is. They can then make sure that they plan in the right way as well.
